Thanks to our friend Phil Rooke who helped us purchase this device for Brightshiners Junior School music lessons. With this, both Phil and our teachers will be able to facilitate joined music classes using modern technology that knows no distance. This will help the pupils have a good time during their music lessons. We are still praying and hoping that God will provide more resources to make the lessons enjoyable. A few children are now able to meet twice in a week to do some music. We can't large numbers on the compound due to covid-19 restrictions. During the lessons we are making sure that there social distancing, sanitizing, and wearing of masks and



plenty of water to wash our hands frequently.



# Staffroom/Office

Our office now occupies the space that we anticipate to serve as staffroom when schools resume! It's completed with a plywood interior finish on both ceiling and walls. The ceiling is painted white while the walls are painted sky blue, isn't this beautiful? This room is fitted with an inbuilt bookshelf which will provide a safe store of our books. We thank God for we were able to purchase a second hand desktop for a relatively cheap price and the device is of much help for the office. We are still hoping to furnish the room with 2 more office tables and chairs, another desktop and 1 laptop and other office accessories. We also hope to install Wi-Fi that will promote research initiatives the facility wishes to engage in innovatively.



## Gardening

Our garden is flourishing so well that it catches the attention of our visitors and friends of Brightshiners junior school.one of the vision of BMG is to see an empowered community. We believe this is one way of empowering them. All those visiting the premise goes out resolving to be creative and use the talents and abilities to empower themselves by at least bringing food on the table hence reducing the dependency syndrome.

Gardening may also be one way to generate income to the school. During school days, the children will eat vegetables and hence healthy pupils and staffs.

## Classrooms

We thank God that our classrooms furnishings and paintings are almost over. We hope and believe to finish soon.

However, the remaining part is the essential items every class needs. If schools could open today, then the boys and girls would learn while standing. We need more financial capital to purchase them, lockers, chairs, blackboards and any other essential item needed in a classroom.

Our director made some inquiries on desks purchase and this is what he found out;

- A ready-made desk at market retail price goes for kes 5000(USD 50).
- We can reduce this amount by half if we bought materials and hire a carpenter to do the furniture for us.

For a start we need 100 desks which amount to kes 500,000(USD 5000) which is a big amount.



# Landscaping

The landscaping now is in the progress. The land will look attractive and also will enable farming activities to take place. We are also working towards installing piped water as well as working with rain water which will greatly enable our farming activities as one key income generating activity.

Praise God! We were able to purchase a desktop for the school ever since the school started at a very reasonable price. We would need more desktops for every classroom for the pupils to learn and be knowledgeable about computer.



## Water connection

Water is life! We all know that right? We have more than enough roof surfaces that can collect water for during rainy season for use in our garden and other water uses. We are in summer period hence no RAIN! We can't collect for now and so we must look for alternative solution to this. We want to make our crops look greener and healthier and so water is the only option which is to connect it to the school in order to have enough and sufficient water for watering the plants and consumption. We have so far applied for pipe water connection and purchased the plumbing materials. We hope to be connected as soon as the water company approves our application and send a plumber to do the connection. The delay has been caused by the ongoing road construction that interfered with the main pipe that will need to be replaced before we can be connected. Since piped water is so expensive, the alternative will be used for gardening purposes. The other future option will be drilling our own water.

## **Road construction**

Praise God! The road construction around Brightshiners School makes it look so beautiful. This came about after our director courageously and confidently negotiated with the supervisor to help in doing the part of diversion at least up to the school gate. This makes us feel a bit relieved because if you could look at the road before construction and during the rain, you could really sympathize with the community's struggle with mad. The road is now passable and so when we resume children will have no trouble accessing the school!

# Chapel

We thank God for He has enabled us through his mercies that we can now meet for fellowships in the new chapel. This came about after our president allowed churches to resume but with a certain number of people attending church. We thank God because all our PTM members can attend the church and fellowship together. You want to meditate anytime without distractions, the chapel is open 24/7. For spiritual formation, friend, the chapel is here and you will feel refreshed.



# Thanks giving ceremony

We took a break from construction work where we released our two masons back to their rural home and family; they really dedicated their efforts and did not give up. They worked tirelessly to make sure that the facility was good looking. We appreciated them by slaughtering a goat for them and so we celebrated with them. We are proud of them when we need them in another round of construction, we won't hesitate to call them back! Our work team included our male staffs whose drive to the work was to see the school recovered. Some have travelled to visit their loved once upcountry and we pray for their safe return. Probably, they are not in a hurry to return there's little activity to engage them now that the schools are still closed but all the same, we appreciate their hard work that saw the construction work well done.

We also cannot fail to observe that the construction exercise went on during all the 3 months of Covid-19 lockdown and travel internal travel restriction and just after our president lifted off the ban, we were ready for the break.
